WASHINGTON-The Securities and Exchange Commission on Tuesday sued Coinbase, a back-to-back punch by regulators seeking to rein in the crypto industry.

The SEC alleged that Coinbase, the largest crypto exchange in the U.S. violated

rules that require it to register as an exchange and be overseen by the federal agency. The case is the second in two days against a major crypto Company. On Monday, the regulator sued the world's largest crypto exchange, Binance, and its founder Changpeng Zhao. The lawsuits are significant
